

Lloyd Combes, age 91, of Storm Lake, Iowa died December 29, 2009 at Methodist Manor Retirement Community in Storm Lake.

Lloyd Henry Combes, son of Bert E. and Eva Elda (Morris) Combes was born August 25, 1918 in Storm Lake, Iowa. He attended Hayes Consolidated School and Sulpher Springs High School.

On June 26, 1943 Lloyd was united in marriage to Fern Bumann at the Baptist Parsonage in Storm Lake. They made their home in Sioux City, Iowa for 63 years and then moved to Storm Lake. They were blessed with two sons, Michael and Craig.
