

Fred Krueger, age 66, of Storm Lake, Iowa died May 18, 2010 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake.

Fred Krueger, son of Raymond and Hilda (Popp) Krueger was born February 10, 1944 in St. Louis, Missouri. As an infant, he was baptized at Bethesda Lutheran Church in St. Louis.


Fred was preceded in death by his parents, Reverend R.A. and Hilda Nee Krueger.
