Betty was preceded in death by her parents; daughter, Lisa Mandernach; brother and sister-in-law, Burdette & Ardie Grieme.



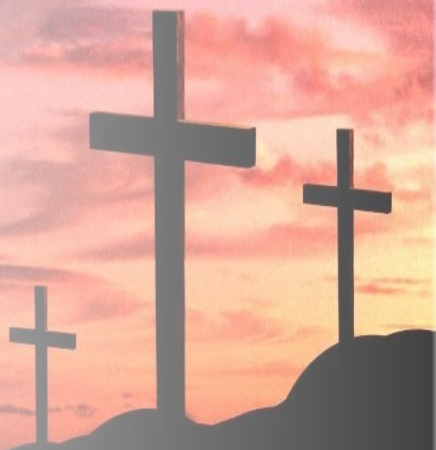
