Nor more tears to cry, 'cause we'll have forever...

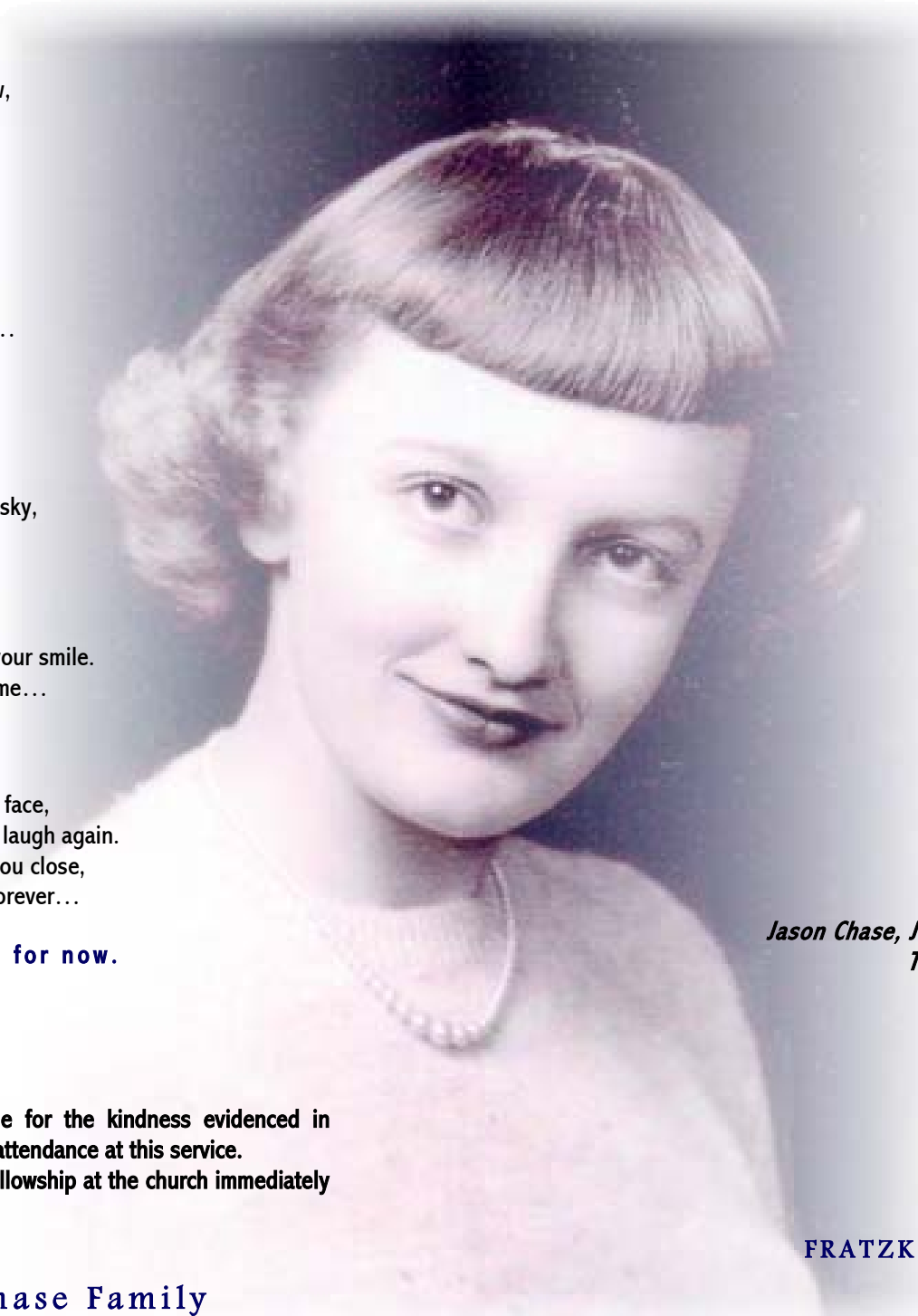
