And bring you back again.

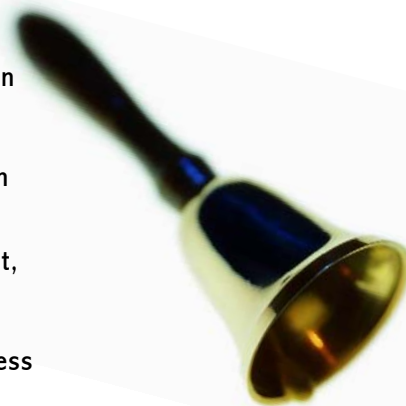
No farewell words were spoken
