Bethel was preceded in death by her parents.

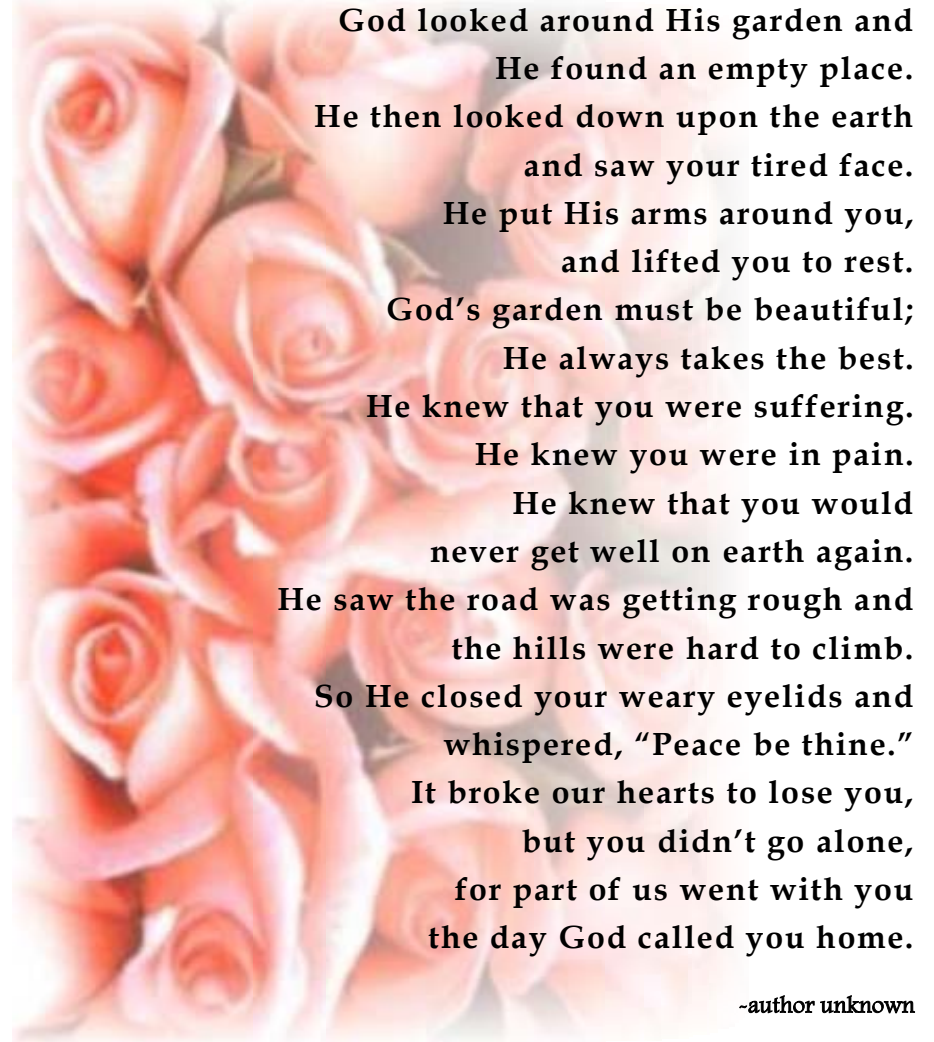


I'd like a memory of me to be a happy one,
