Arthur W. Grundmeier, age 87, of Storm Lake, Iowa died on Thursday, July 3, 2008 at the Methodist Manor in Storm Lake.

Arthur Wilbert Grundmeier was born on March 17, 1921 to August and Marie (Ploeger) Grundmeier in Buena Vista County. The family moved back to the farm in Eden Township, Sac County where he went to school.

On July 10, 1944, Art married Arlene Bernhardt at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Schaller. They had four children: Ann, Barbara, Carol and Dennis. They lived 51 years on the same farm in Eden Township, where he also raised livestock. In 1995, they moved

to Emerald Park then in 2007, they moved to Lake Point Villa in Storm Lake.
