

Inez McKeighan Latta, age 93, of Storm Lake, Iowa, died Wednesday, January 23, 2008 at Methodist Manor in Storm Lake.

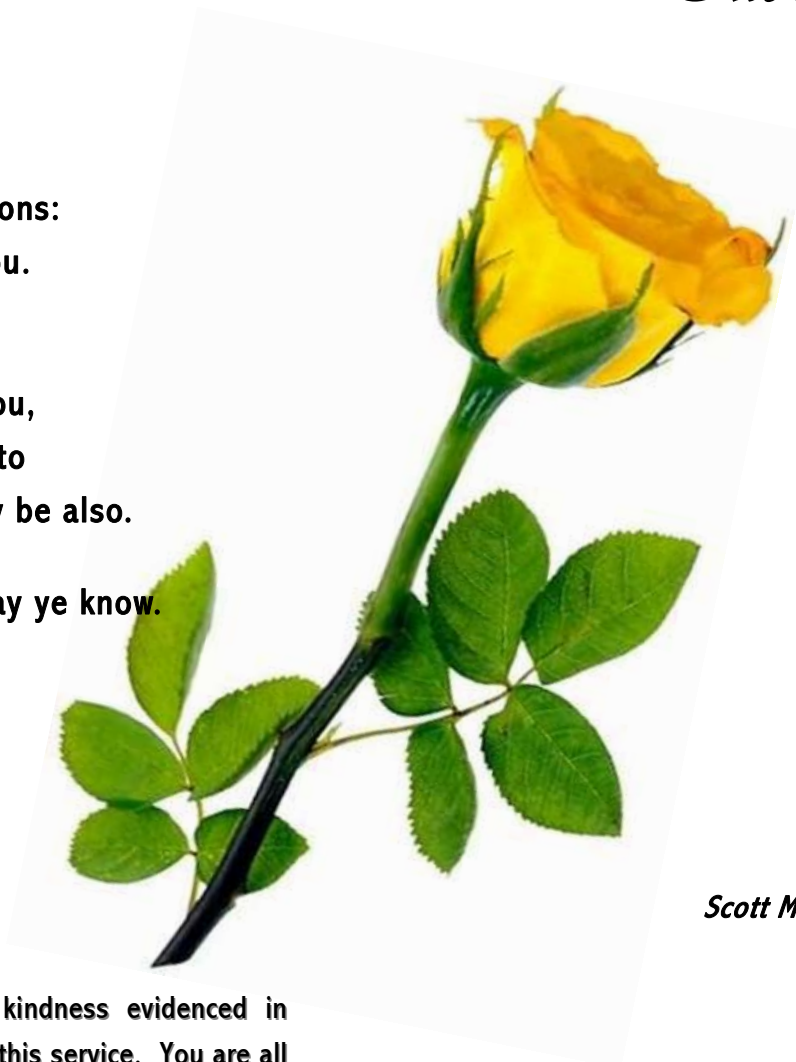
