Arlene Frances Vilas, age 98 of Storm Lake, Iowa, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on Wednesday, April 14, 2021 at Methodist Manor in Storm Lake, after a short battle with cancer.

Celebration of Life service will take place Friday, July 23, 2021 from 3-6:00 p.m. at the KC Hall in Storm Lake. Private family burial will be at a later date.
