April 25, 1921 - February 15, 2013

Doris Patterson, age 91, of Alta, Iowa died Friday, February 15, 2013 at her home in Alta. Doris Jean Hatch was born April 25, 1921 in Marathon, Iowa, the daughter of Bert R. and Mabel (Wall) Hatch. She attended Alta Consolidated Schools, graduating with the Class of 1939. She was a member of the Alta United Methodist Church, where she sang in the choir for many years.
