Albert Sefcik, age 80, of Pocahontas, Iowa died Wednesday, March 30, 2016 at his home in Pocahontas.

Funeral Mass will be held Saturday, April 2, 2016 at 10:30 a.m. at Resurrection of Our Lord Catholic Church in Pocahontas. Burial will follow in the Calvary Cemetery in Pocahontas. Visitation will begin at 9:00 a.m. until the beginning of the service at the church. In lieu of flowers, a memorial fund in Albert's name has been established. Albert James Sefcik was born April 23, 1935 in Pocahontas, Iowa, the son of Adolph and Agnes (Bunda) Sefcik.
