Alice Lorraine (Boisen) Pinnekamp, age 95, of Schaller, Iowa passed away on July 3, 2025 at Methodist Manor Retirement Community in Storm Lake.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, July 10, 2025 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Schaller. Burial will be in the Immanuel Lutheran Cemetery in Odebolt. Alice studied piano and organ for five years at Buena Vista College, and was the organist for St. Paul Lutheran Church in Schaller for 10 years. She also played for church services at the Odebolt Nursing Home. She was Treasurer

of Ladies Aid for several years and a life-long member of St. Paul Lutheran Church.

Alice and John retired and moved into their home in Schaller in May, 1981. They enjoyed ballroom dancing and traveling, especially to Army-Air Force Reunions. Alice enjoyed reading, quilting, and machine embroidery. Since late 2018, Alice lived at the Methodist Manor Retirement Center (MMRC) in Storm Lake. Alice's family is grateful to everyone at MMRC for the wonderful care and support provided to Alice.
