Barbara Stammer of Rochester, Minnesota died Tuesday, September 1, 2015 at Cottagewood Senior Communities in Rochester.

Funeral services will be held at 11:00 a.m. on September 5, 2015 at the Storm Lake United Methodist Church with the Reverend Matthew Miller officiating. The family will greet friends at a visitation that morning from 10:00-11:00 a.m. Burial will be in the Pilot Township Cemetery, rural Cherokee. 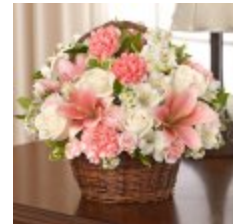
