Betty J. McCrory, age 91, of Holstein, Iowa died Wednesday, June 29, 2022 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake, Iowa.

Memorial services will take place Wednesday, July 6, 2022 at 10:30 a.m. at the St. Mark Lutheran Church in Storm Lake, Iowa. Burial will be in the Storm Lake Cemetery. 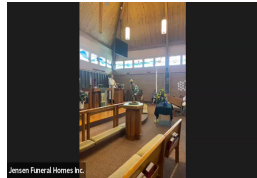
