Betty Lou Miller, age 86, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Thursday, August 27, 2015 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake.

Memorial services will be held Wednesday, September 2, 2015 at 2:00 p.m. at the Lakeside Presbyterian Church in Storm Lake. Visitation will take place Tuesday, September 1, 2015 from 6-8:00 p.m. in the Fireside Room at the Lakeside Presbyterian Church in Storm Lake. Betty Lou Darrow was born July 12, 1929, the daughter of Ralph E. and Zelda (Brown) Darrow in Revanna, Nebraska. She went to grade school in Alta, Iowa and Storm Lake, Iowa and graduated from Storm Lake High School in 1949. She attended Buena Vista University in Storm Lake, Iowa briefly where she met fellow classmate, Marvin Miller. They were married January 26, 1951. They had three children, David, Patricia and Timothy.

Betty spent most of her life as a housewife, staying home and caring for her children. She spent a short time as a teacher's aid and several years as a Nursing Assistant working in hospitals and nursing homes. She received the Governor's award for volunteerism for volunteering in the Storm Lake primary school where she volunteered in the Kindergarten class for several years. She was an excellent pianist and organist and where ever she was located she

served as a substitute organist in the church. She volunteered as organist at what is now North Lake Manor in Storm Lake, playing for worship services when called and weekly as entertainment for the residents until her hands became too stiff with arthritis to play comfortably.

She was preceded in death by her parents and a sister-in-law, Dorothy Darrow. Betty leaves to mourn her passing her husband, Marvin Miller of Storm Lake, Iowa; brother, Jack Darrow of Albert City, Iowa; sister, Dolores (Bud) Phillips of Alta, Iowa; children, David (Tammy) Miller of Storm Lake, Iowa; Patricia Bainbridge of Mapleton, Iowa; Tim (Gayle) Miller of Storm Lake, Iowa; eight grandchildren; nineteen great grandchildren; and very many nieces, nephews, cousins and many friends.

Last name: Darrow

TThis interesting surname is a variant of Darragh, for which there are two likely origins. The most probable origin is as a patronymic name from the Scottish Gaelic MacDara, "son of oak". The Stirling Darrochs derived their name from a placename Darroch, near Falkirk. Mariote Darrach appears as a nurse of Lady Margaret, second daughter of James 11 in 1462. Varying spellings of the name include Darrocht 1550, Darroycht 1553, and Darroche 1561. Darragh is also an Irish name occasionally found with the prefix mac, mainly associated with north-east Ulster, and is Anglicized as "Oakes", as "dair" is gaelic for oak. Maclysaght in his "More Irish Families" says that the name was in Ireland before the immigration of the Scottish during the Plantation of Ulster and equates the early MacDwdara with MacDubhdare which is the gaelic form of MacDarragh. The name appears as Dorrageh or Dorah in the Hearth Money Rolls of Tyrone (1664) and Antrim (1669). James Darragh was one of the Fenian prisoners transported to Australia escaping to New York in 1876. A.S. Darragh, a mechanic is recorded as immigrating from Belfast to New York with two sons and a daughter on the ship "Prince-de-Joinville" on June 28th 1847. The first recorded spelling of the family name is shown to be that of John Darach, which was dated 1406, in the "Exchequer Rolls of Scotland" (1264 - 1600), during the reign of King James 1, of England and V1 of Scotland, 1603 - 1625.

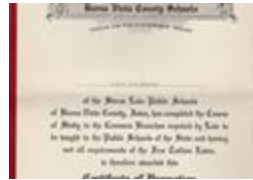
