He was a single man until he met Mrs. Orathai Suriyavong, then married her in 2004. Together, they had two children: David and Nicolas Praseuthsinh.

Mr. Bounlap was a very gentle and loving man to his wife, children, friends, and family. He was highly respected and will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

He was preceded in death by his father, Mr. Pe Praseuthsinh. He is survived by his wife and children.
