Carol J. Lundberg, age 75, of Omaha, Nebraska and formerly of Albert City, Iowa passed away April 6, 2023 at her Omaha home.

A Celebration of Life service will be held Saturday, May 20, 2023 at 11:00 a.m. at Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Albert City. Burial will be in the Fairfield Township Cemetery in Albert City. Visitation will take place one hour prior to the service at the church. The Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake is in charge of the arrangements.

Carol was born on May 28, 1947, in Storm Lake, Iowa. Her parents were Carl and Minnie Lundberg of Marathon, Iowa. She was welcomed by her older sister, Janet (Gale).

The family lived on a family farm 4 miles north and 1/2 mile east from Albert city. She was baptized and confirmed at Our Savior's Lutheran Church. She attended many summer church

camps in Okoboji, Iowa. Many of the camp songs sang in her heart throughout her life.

Carol graduated from Albert City - Truesdale Community Schools in 1965.

During the summers

and Saturdays, she worked at Superior Manufacturing Company, paying her way through

college, graduating with her BAE in 1969.

She started her teaching career at Westside Community School, Omaha, Ne. and taught there

for 42 years. She received her Master of Science Degree in Improvement of Instruction Degree

in 1989 from the University of Nebraska at Omaha. After retiring she enjoyed substitute

teaching.

In fighting cancer for 2.5 years much prayer and confession of God's promises helped her to

deepen her personal relationship with The Lord. She never became angry or discouraged. It was

her hope, love and faith in The Lord that kept heart and soul focused on HIM and not the evil of

the disease.

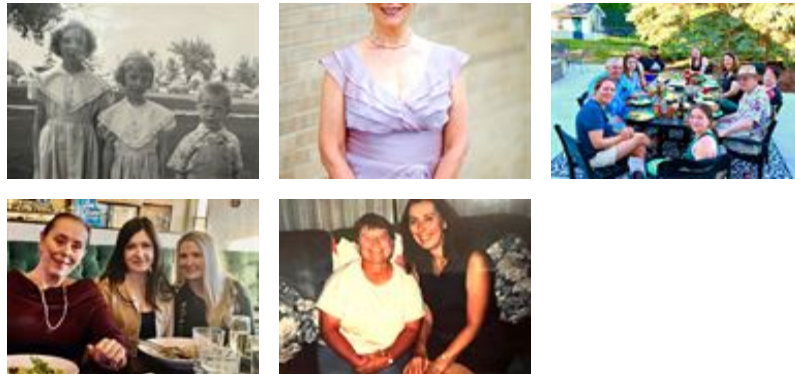
