Carolyn A. Stull, age 88, of Storm Lake, Iowa died March 13, 2021 at Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake.

Carolyn enjoyed playing cards and board games and crafting. She especially liked cooking for family gatherings, no one ever left hungry. Many visitors found this out as she never would let you leave

without something to eat.

The Stull farm served as a summer home for many nieces, nephews, and grandchildren. Some of the memories at the farm include helping in the garden, picking mulberries, and twirling in the tire swing.

Carolyn lived on the farm until after Dean's death in 2004 when she purchased a home in Storm Lake. She then sold her home in 2018 and moved to Wel-Life where she became reacquainted with many old friends and made many new ones.
