Caite as she was called always told how she was born on the hottest day ,July19,of 19930. She has born in the same house she grew up in with her parents Ernest and Dorthy Dix and her 7 siblings. She survived 4 of them with 3 saving her.

Cait went to school in Missouri Valley from grade school thru senior high. Cait then taught grade school as a certified teacher as did her mother Dorthey and sister Maxine.

She told how she meether future husband at the skating rink and what a skater he was! They were married on August 19th 1949.

They were together till Cliffs death in Dec.23, 2015

Cait told how Cliff worked the morning of the wedding. They were married at the church had a cake,made by future brother-in-law, and punch reception . After the short reception Cliff returned to work. imagine that

This marriage was blessed with 5 children. Dave spouse Andi Berg, Christine spouse Lorne Gano ,Sue Ellen Bonham ,Daniel spouse Penny Goodmen, Caroline spouse Richard Ecker.

Cait and Cliff lived in Missouri Valley untill1958. They moved to Storm Lake IA and purchased a house on 4th street . Caite's Dad said they couldn't afford a house that big and the cost ridicules they would never afford the payment ,but the did 56.00dollars a month! That house was torn down and the land is part of BV college parking lot. They built a house on a oak Lane and the marriage survived.They sold that house and bought one on Larchwood St with a shared driveway. Caite said that driveway was always a sore spot with them.

Caite worked at the GStore Ireland Drug. She also sold real-estate for a while.She and Cliff took jobs in Des Moines Iowa as house parents. After retiering from that job,they sold the house in Storm Lake and moved to Aurelia IA. Caite loved it there big back yard full of flowers.A great place forteaparties and poetry readingCaite wrote many poems and short stories . It's only appropriate she would want her memorial money to go to the Storm Lake library.Caite was instrumental in starting the Church of the Nazareth in Storm Lake Caite always said God gave them a family that blessed them with a

full quiver of Grandchildren, Shane and Miles Bonham, Amy, Lori .and Jeny Gano. Lynn and Michael Bonham Katie and Eric Johnson

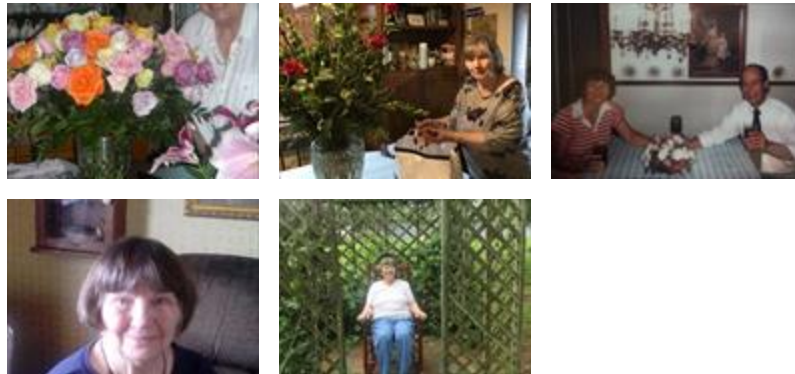

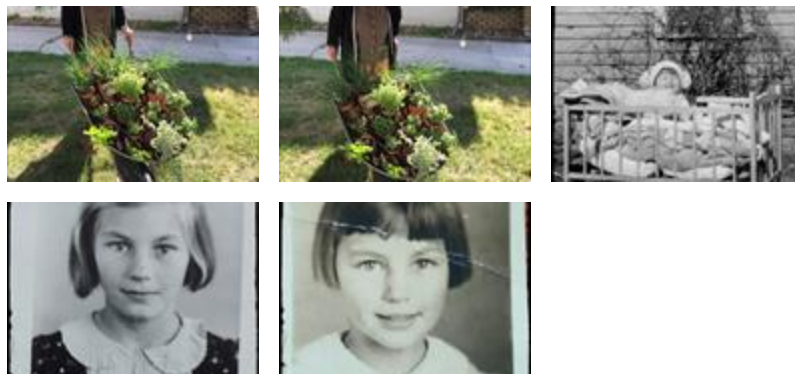
