Charles Barlow, age 82, of Schaller, Iowa died Monday, December 8, 2014 at the Horn Memorial Hospital in Ida Grove, Iowa.

Funeral services will be held Friday, December 12, 2014 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Schaller. Burial will be in the Schaller Cemetery. Chuck was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church in Schaller where he served as president of the congregation, trustee, and also elder.

Chuck was a member of the Schaller VFW, Farm Bureau and served on the Schaller Co-op elevator board.

Chuck enjoyed woodworking and being outdoors, especially fishing and gardening. In his spare time, he enjoyed watching Westerns and visiting with friends over a cup of coffee. He also took pride in teasing his Iowa State University friends. Chuck loved his family and treasured spending time with them. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.
