Charles E. Gustafson, age 84, of Storm Lake, Iowa, died Monday, March 4, 2024 at St. Mary's Hospital in Rochester, Minnesota.

Celebration of Life services will be held Saturday, March 23, 2024 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Storm Lake. Burial will be in the Storm Lake Cemetery. Charles was always ready to play dice and cards with the grandkids or attend their sporting events and concerts. He enjoyed art work and painted a special painting for each and every grandchild and great-grandchild that he currently had. At family gatherings you could find Charles videotaping and narrating the events. In his free time, he could also be found watching western or war movies. Charles loved taking care of his three kitties.
