Chris M. Laursen, 95, of Newell, Iowa, died Saturday, September 24, 2016, at the Good Samaritan Society, Newell, Iowa.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday, September 27, 2016 at 11:00 a.m. at the Nain Lutheran Church in Newell. Burial will be in the Newell Cemetery with full military rites. Christian (Chris) Marion Laursen, was born in Battle Creek, Iowa, on September 6, 1921, the first son of Ellen (Henricksen) and Karl Christian Laursen. He was later baptized into his Christian faith. He grew up and received his education in Battle Creek, graduating from Battle Creek High School.

Chris served in the United States Air Corps as a gunner during World War II. On February 26, 1947, he was married in the Ida Grove Church of God to Harriette Claire Shirk. They were blessed with four children, Sharen, Cynthia, Susan and Lynn. Chris was an active member of Nain Lutheran Church.

They farmed in Battle Creek and Ida Grove for several years before moving to Newell, Iowa, in 1960. Chris was employed throughout the years by Sievers

He served several years on Newell's library board and was a dedicated follower of the Newell-Fonda Mustangs. Chris also enjoyed gardening and especially the competition with Harriette for best flowers and vegetables.

He was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather who was generous with his talents and kindness. All who knew and loved him, came to understand his humor, especially his favorite quote, "You can always tell a Dane, but you can't tell him much!"

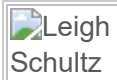
