Creighton Verle Millard, age 91, died Monday morning, September 28, 2015, at the Methodist Manor in Storm Lake, Iowa. He was surrounded by loving family.

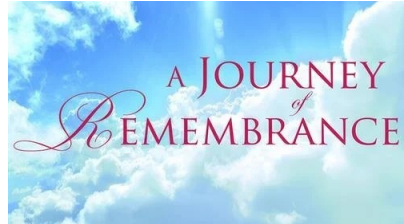
