Curt Eckerman, age 58, of Sioux City, Iowa and formerly of Holstein, Iowa passed away February 25, 2012 in Sioux City as a result of injuries suffered from an accident November 23, 2011. Curtis William Eckerman was born March 26, 1953 in Cherokee, Iowa the son of Romane and Bonnie (Miller) Eckerman. As an infant, he was baptized at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church in Holstein where he was later confirmed during his youth. Growing up, Curt attended school in Holstein where he graduated from Holstein High School in 1971. Throughout high school, Curt was very active in extracurricular activities and lettered in all sports. He was a very talented young man and sang in the high school choir as well. Following high school and throughout his life, he worked construction. Curt was currently a member of St. Boniface Catholic Church in Sioux City. He served on the Board of Directors of Mental Health America of Siouxland since 2008. Curt was a volunteer for many years as the Life Skills Coach of Henry Muller Hall, which has operated since 2005 to transition men from homelessness to an integrated community life. One of Curt's passions was his involvement in the Siouxland Sleep-out to End Homelessness.
