Daryl Dean Schade, age 78, of Newell, Iowa died Tuesday, July 5, 2016 at Black Hawk Life Care Center in Lake View, Iowa.

Daryl Dean Schade was born October 20, 1937 in Calhoun County Iowa, the son of Henry and Freida (Kreft) Schade.

As an infant, he was baptized at St. Peter's Coon Valley Township in Lytton. In 1952, he confirmed his faith at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Sac City.

Daryl attended grade school at Williams #9 in Calhoun County. In 1956, he graduated from Lytton High School. He continued his education at the Sioux City Barber College in Sioux City, Iowa where he graduated from in 1961. Daryl then began his 55 year long career as a barber.

In 1954, Daryl entered the United States Army Reserves. He was honorably discharged on January 31, 1964.

On March 3, 1960, Daryl was united in marriage to Glenda Rohde at Our Redeemer's Lutheran Church in Jackson, Minnesota. Together, they were blessed with two children: Dean Douglas and Renea Kay.

Daryl was an active member of Grace Lutheran Church in Storm Lake where he was participated in the Men's Club.

He loved raising, training, and showing Quarter horses and was a member of the Northwest Iowa Quarter Horse Association. He enjoyed trail rides and cattle roundups in Wyoming. He also was a talented leather crafter. Most of all, Daryl loved spending time with his family and friends. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.
