David J. Lampe, age 62, of Columbia, Missouri, formerly of Fonda, Iowa passed away May 26, 2017 at the University Hospital in Columbia.

A Memorial Mass will be held Saturday, June 10, 2017 at 10:30 a.m. at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church in Fonda. Burial will follow in the Mt. Zion Catholic Cemetery in Fonda. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service at the church. The Mahaney Funeral Home in Fonda is in charge of the arrangements.

David was born on February 16th, 1955 in Fonda, Iowa to Bernard and Eleanor Lampe.

Dave grew up in Fonda, Iowa, where he graduated from OLGCC Catholic High School in 1973. After high school, he attended Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska. He then married his high school sweetheart in October of 1977 and he moved back home. He helped farm his family's land for several years before becoming a business owner of a feed and farm supply store in Sac City, Iowa. In 1987, he moved with his family to Columbia, Missouri, where he worked for US Rents It as General Manager for over 29 years.

Dave enjoyed spending time with friends and family. His friends were like family and he was always willing to give up his evenings and weekends

whenever someone needed his expertise or help. He was an avid gun collector who researched and knew the historical significance of each gun that he owned. He enjoyed teaching others and sharing his hobby with all who showed interest. He enjoyed fishing and the outdoors. He cherished the opportunity to teach his grandchildren all that he knew. He was a 29 year member of the Elks Lodge in Columbia, MO, as well as a long time member of the NRA.

Dave is survived by his 3 beloved daughters and their husbands, Kristi Lampe-Naidech (Dr. Andrew Naidech) of Chicago, IL; Kari Lampe (Clayton Meldi) of Columbia, MO; and Kayla Banks (Bryan Banks) of Champaign, IL. He cherished his 6 grandchildren, Anna, Benjamin, and Aden Naidech, Logan and Olivia Meldi, and Emery Banks. His parents Bernard "Bud" and Eleanor "Ellie" Lampe of Fonda, IA, and 4 siblings, Marlene Cimpl (John) of Columbus, NE; Richard Lampe of Fonda, IA; Steve Lampe of Newell, IA; and Eileen Hornor (Jim) of Fonda, IA, survive him as well. He loved his 8 nieces, 2 nephews and many great nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his 2 younger brothers, Jerome and Michael, whom he joins in Heaven. A memorial service took place at the Elks Lodge in Columbia, MO on May 31st, where friends and family gathered to honor and remember his life.
