David Wendell Schmidt, age 66, of Schaller, Iowa, passed away on May 17, 2025, surrounded by his loving family.

He found joy in life's simple pleasures: taking long truck rides with his loyal dog by his side, tending to his garden with care, spending peaceful mornings in the woods hunting, and proudly cheering from the stands at his daughter's and later at his grandchildren's sporting events. He rarely missed a game, and his pride in his family was one of his defining qualities.
