Diane Wogahn, age 56, of Storm Lake, Iowa, died February 12, 2011 at the Buena Vista Regional Medical Center in Storm Lake. Diane Lynda was born December 6, 1954 to Herb and Ruth Evans at Andrews AFB in Washington, D.C. She was baptized January 2, 1955 by Chaplain Martin Pack at Andrews AFB Chapel and later confirmed on April 20, 1975 at Grace Lutheran Church in Storm Lake by Pastor Robert Bailey. She has been employed by the Buena Vista Work Activity Center and Genesis Development Center since 1973. Diane became a resident of Good Samaritan Center in Newell, Iowa on September 18, 2007.
