



## Don Siebrecht

Don Siebrecht, age 79, of Arthur, Iowa died on Monday, December 14, 2020 at the MercyOne Medical Center in Sioux City, Iowa.

Public funeral services will be held on Friday, December 18, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. at the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Schaller. Burial will be in the Odebolt Cemetery in Odebolt. Visitation will take place prior to the service from 12:00-2:00 p.m. at the CHURCH. Masks and social distancing are required for all guests in attendance at the services.
