Donald J. Stieneke, age 89, formerly of Alta, Iowa passed away on Monday, May 29, 2017 peacefully in his sleep at Lancaster Manor in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Funeral services will be held Friday, June 2, 2017 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Alta. Burial will be in the St. John Lutheran Cemetery in Hanover. During his naval experience, he corresponded with Helen Grieme, who he met at a church youth rally.

Don and Helen were married on April 24, 1949 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Alta. Together they shared 68 years of marriage and were blessed with four

children, Daniel, Patricia, Charles, and Kristi.

They started farming in 1953 on a farm north of Alta and retired from farming in 1988.

Don had many hobbies and interests. He enjoyed woodworking, making stained glass, playing cards with friends, fishing, politics, and camping across the United States.

Don was an active member of Grace Lutheran Church in Storm Lake, Iowa and St. Paul Lutheran Church in Alta, Iowa. He served several offices in both congregations.
