Donald Schramm, age 89, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Friday, May 3, 2013 at North Lake Manor in Storm Lake. Donald Roy Schramm was born April 17, 1924 in Albert City, Iowa, the son of Henry and Sophia (Lehman) Schramm. He attended grade school in Albert City.
