Dorothy V. Krohn, age 92, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Tuesday, March 17, 2015 at Methodist Manor Retirement Community in Storm Lake.

Funeral services will be held Monday, March 23, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Storm Lake. Burial will follow in the Buena Vista Memorial Park Cemetery in Storm Lake. On February 20, 1943, Dorothy was united in marriage to William L. Weatherly in Kirksville, Missouri. Together, they were blessed with three children: Barbara, Marjorie, and Timothy. After Bill passed away, she later married George Krohn on July 15, 1985 in Storm Lake, Iowa.

Dorothy was a member of the Cosmopolitan Club, I.O.O.F., and Business and Professional Women. She belonged to Delta Kappa Gamma where she served as treasurer.
