Edith Marie (Veehoff) Harrington, age 88, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Tuesday, November 4, 2014 with her loving family at her side.

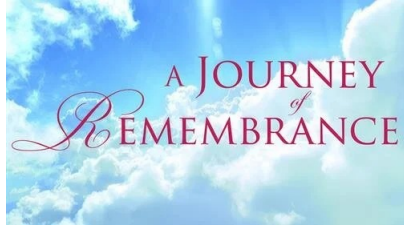
