Edith Marie Olsen, age 96, of Newell, Iowa, passed away on January 10, 2026.

Funeral services will take place Saturday, January 17, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. at Bethel Baptist Church in Newell. Burial will be in Newell Cemetery. Edith was born on January 4, 1930 in Lake Norden, South Dakota to Reverend Albert and Lillie (Larson) Osborne. Edith was the youngest of four children.
