Edward "Ted" Pierick, age 87, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Tuesday, April 7, 2015 at North Lake Manor in Storm Lake.

Funeral Mass will be held Saturday, April 11, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Storm Lake. Burial will follow at Mt. St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery in Anthon, Iowa. Visitation will take place Friday, April 10, 2015 from 5-7:00 p.m. with a Knights of Columbus Rosary at 6:30 p.m. all at the Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake. Ted was a faithful member of the St. Mary's Catholic Church in Storm Lake. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus, where he had received the honor of 4th Degree Knight. Ted was also a member of the Alta VFW Post #6172.

In his spare time, Ted kept busy with work and his family. He also enjoyed playing cards. Ted will be remembered as a devoted father, grandfather, great grandfather, brother, and friend to many. He will be deeply missed.


