Eggert Thomsen, age 96, of Newell, Iowa died Wednesday, February 8, 2023 at his residence in Newell.

He then enlisted in the Marines where he trained for D-Day, but did not need to serve.

On September 14, 1946, Eggert was united in marriage to Alberta (Kaskadden) Thomsen in What Cheer, Iowa. To this union, six children were born: Donna, Donald, Rex, Ruth, Susan, and Shirley. On August 9, 2007, Eggert and Inez (Cressler) Thomsen were married at the Methodist Church in Newell, Iowa.

Eggert worked as a baker, a meat cutter, a real estate agent and a published author until his retirement in 2017 at the age of 90. In his free time, Eggert was an avid sports fan. The Iowa Hawkeyes, Kansas City Chiefs, and Atlanta Braves were a few of his favorite teams and he coached Little League for many years. He also loved fishing and watching westerns and Lawrence Welk. More than anything, Eggert treasured time with his family. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

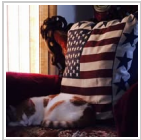
