Elizabeth S. Merten, age 73, of Storm Lake, Iowa died on Tuesday, July 31, 2018 at the Mercy Medical Center in Des Moines, Iowa.

On June 3, 1963, Elizabeth enlisted in the United States Army to serve her country during the Vietnam War era. She was honorably discharged on October 12, 1964.

Elizabeth joined the Catholic Church in August of 1964 in Kannapolis, North Carolina. On October 3, 1964 she was united in marriage to Richard Francis

Merten in Kannapolis, North Carolina. The couple was blessed with one daughter, Lisa Ann Merten.

Elizabeth believed in life-long learning, she graduated in 1985 with a bachelor's degree in Accounting from Buena Vista College in Storm Lake. She then pursued to earn her master's degree in Human Resources in 2006 from Briar Cliff University in Sioux City. Elizabeth also attended the University of Kentucky where she received a degree in Business Management. She was invested in her work and held numerous Human Resource Certifications including: Society for Human Resource Management – Senior Certified Professional (SCP), Human Resource Certification Institute - Senior Professional in Human Resources (SPHR) and Drake University - Employment Law.

Elizabeth worked at Buena Vista University for over 39 years. She retired in 2016 as the Vice President of Business Services; the same year that she was awarded an Honorary Doctorate Degree in Business from Buena Vista University.

In her free time, Elizabeth enjoyed gardening, restoring antiques, reading, and sitting on the deck by her flower gardens. She loved Australian Shepherd puppies and Mustang cars. She loved to travel in the South and to the beaches of North and South Carolina.

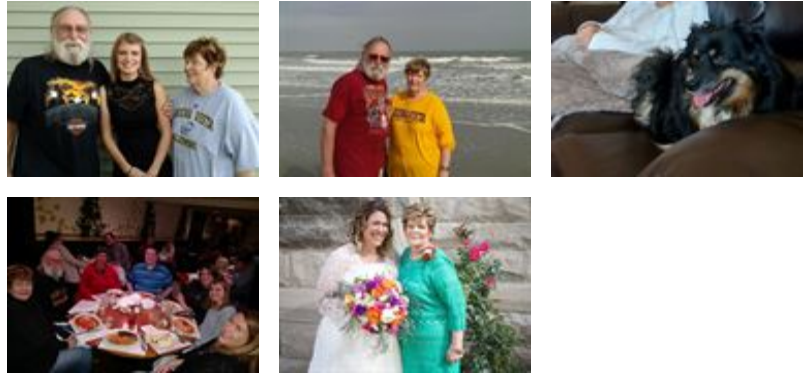

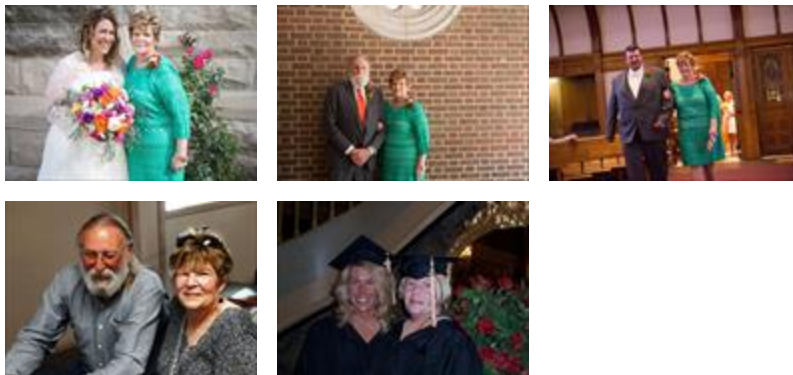
