



## Ella M. (Lohrman) Hageman Wilson

January 4, 1903 - October 19, 2011

Ella M. (Lohrman) Hageman Wilson, age 108, of Storm Lake, Iowa died October 19, 2011 at the Methodist Manor Retirement Community in Storm Lake. Ella Was born January 4, 1903 in Westside, Iowa the daughter of Albert and Anna (Kruthoff) Lohrman. She was baptized when she was five days old into the Lutheran faith at her home.
