April 24, 1914 - December 9, 2010

Elvera H. Anderson, age 96, of Storm Lake, Iowa, was the last remaining member of her immediate family when she passed into the presence of her Lord and Savior on December 9, 2010 at the Pleasant View Home in Albert City, Iowa. Elvera was born April 24, 1914 in rural Marshall township of Pocahontas county, Iowa to Erick Bjorklund and Ida (Anderson) Bjorklund. She lived on her parent's farm near Albert City, Iowa and attended a one-room grammar school east of Albert City. Elvera graduated from Albert City H.S. in 1932. The last several years of Elvera's life has been at Pleasant View Home in Albert City. Elvera enjoyed gardening and sewing. She was an avid sports fan of her children's baseball and basketball games. She was a faithful member of Hope Evangelical Free Church in Storm Lake where she was involved with the White Cross and WMS. She was a member of the Mother of Twins Club.
