Emmett Witte, age 86, of Schaller, Iowa died Sunday, May 3, 2015 at his home in Schaller.

Funeral services will take place Thursday, May 7, 2015 at 10:30 a.m. at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Schaller. Burial will be in the Schaller Cemetery. Visitation will be held Wednesday, May 6, 2015 from 5-8:00 p.m. at the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Schaller. The Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Schaller is in charge of the arrangements.

Emmett Arnold Witte was born August 4, 1928 in rural Ida Grove, Iowa the son of Henry and Magdalena (Wunschel) Witte. On September 2, 1928 Emmett was baptized at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Ida Grove. On April 18, 1943, he was confirmed at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Cook Township Sac County.

Growing up, Emmett attended Cook Township #4 where he graduated from the 8th grade.

On April 14, 1951, Emmett was enlisted in the United States Army where he served his country during the Korean Conflict. He was honorably discharged on January 7, 1953.

Following his honorable discharge, Emmett started farming one mile west of Schaller on the Spindler farm.

On August 5, 1956, Emmett was united in marriage to Laura Lee Weiland at St. John Lutheran Church in Galva, Iowa. Together, they were blessed with two daughters: Karla Lee and Karen Rane.

In 1971, Emmett and Laura together bought a farm six miles south of Schaller from his sister and brother-in-law, Irene and Chris Carstensen. It was there that they made their home on this farm until moving into Schaller in 2003.

Emmett was a member of the St. Paul Lutheran Church in Schaller where he was a voting member, a trustee, and an usher.

A favorite past time of Emmett's was playing cards and casino trips with friends. He also loved golfing and bowling. Emmett enjoyed watching any sporting event that he could, especially the Chicago Cubs. His lifetime passion was farming and raising cattle. He enjoyed making frequent trips out to the farm to help whenever possible. He was a dedicated and loving father, grandfather, great grandfather, brother, and friend. Family was very important to Emmett and he treasured spending time with family and friends. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

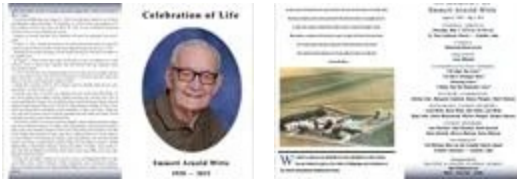
