Evelyn M. Cook, age 93, of Davenport, Iowa formerly of Storm Lake, Iowa died Sunday, January 8, 2017 in Davenport.

Funeral Mass will be held Thursday, January 12, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Storm Lake. Burial will follow in the Sacred Heart Cemetery in Laurens, Iowa. Some of Evelyn's best memories were of Loren and her playing golf and dancing at the Cobblestone. They loved to jitterbug & one time won a dance trophy. They were fun to watch. Her family loved visiting her. She made family times special with awesome meals (especially swiss steak), games, and laughter. Christmas was the best. Her smile and laughter made it so. Her grandchildren and great grandchildren have great memories with her. She made each one feel extra special.

Retiring from farming, Evelyn and Loren moved to Laurens. They continued to enjoy golf with friends. Much of her time was spent caring for her mother, mother-in-law, and Loren. She had a caring heart and uplifted others with a lot of teasing and laughter.
