



Floyd "Bud" Dierenfeld

December 27, 1919 - July 12, 2009

Floyd "Bud" Otto Dierenfeld, age 89, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Sunday, July 12, 2009 at Buena Vista Manor in Storm Lake. Funeral services will be 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 14, 2009 at St. John Lutheran Church in Storm Lake. Visitation will be held 1 hour prior to the service at the church. Burial will be in the Buena Vista Memorial Park Cemetery. The Amvets Post #66 will conduct military rites. The Fratzke & Jensen Funeral Home in Storm Lake is in charge of the arrangements. Floyd Otto Dierenfeld was born December 27, 1919 in Wall Lake, Iowa, the son of Otto and Clara (Polzein) Dierenfeld. In 1920 he was baptized and on April 15, 1936 he was confirmed at the Peace Lutheran Church in Wall Lake. Floyd attended grade school in Wall Lake and later earned a degree as an Electronic Technician. He entered into the United States Navy on November 22, 1940 where he served in World War II. Floyd was honorably discharged on September 27, 1945. On September 5, 1944, Floyd married Wanda Bettin in Wall Lake. This couple was blessed with nine children; Ayric, Rod, Deris, Denise, Jon, David, Teresa, Lisa and Michele. Floyd was a member of the American Vets Post #66 in Storm Lake, Iowa. He was an Engineer for Buena Vista County and owned D & D Repair. He later retired in September of 1983.
