Frank Trimble, age 93, of Storm Lake, Iowa died on Sunday, April 29, 2018 at the Good Samaritan Society in Newell, Iowa.

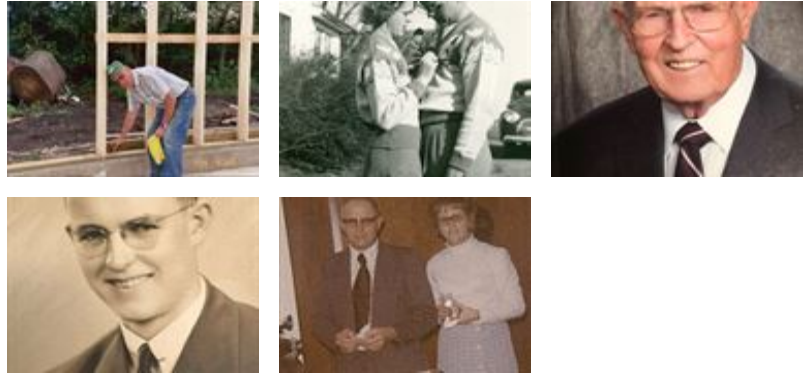
