Frieda P. Honeck, age 98, of Storm Lake, Iowa formerly of Early, Iowa died Sunday, February 12, 2017 at Methodist Manor Retirement Community in Storm Lake.

Frieda Pauline Pagel was born April 5, 1918 in Wall Lake, Iowa, the daughter of Herman and Anna (Vogel) Pagel.
