Garnet Adams, 85, of Bridge City, Texas and formerly of Newell, Iowa, passed from this life to her eternal home on Friday, October 30, 2015, at her daughter's home in Bridge City.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. Monday, November 2, 2015, in the chapel of Claybar Funeral Home in Bridge City. Officiating will be Bud Davis with music led by Michael Rodriguez. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service.

Funeral services will also be held on Saturday, November 14, 2015 at 12:00 p.m. at the First Baptist Church in Storm Lake. Interment will follow in the Storm Lake Cemetery.
