Gary S. Christen, age 74, of Storm Lake, Iowa passed away December 25, 2021 in Des Moines, Iowa.

after completing 36 years.

He was united into marriage with Joan Johnson on July 28, 1979. He was a member of St. Mark's Lutheran Church in Storm Lake. He has two children, Michael and Christy.

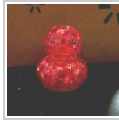

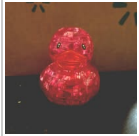

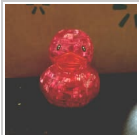
