H. Frank Taylor, age 97, of Storm Lake, Iowa died April 26, 2014 at Mercy Medical Center in Sioux City, Iowa.

Frank was born January 23, 1917 in the family home north of Storm Lake, Iowa, the son of Joseph Ferman and Harriet Elizabeth (Jordon) Taylor. Growing up, Frank attended school at Lincoln Lee School.
