Harold J. North, age 87, of Storm Lake, Iowa died Wednesday, June 26, 2024 at Accura Healthcare in Aurelia, Iowa.

Memorial services will take place Monday, July 1, 2024 at 10:30 a.m. at the United Methodist Church in Storm Lake, Iowa. Burial will be in the Buena Vista Memorial Park Cemetery in Storm Lake.
