Janice Pitstick, age 81, of Fonda, Iowa passed away November 17, 2024 at her home south of Fonda.

Funeral services will take place Saturday, November 23, 2024 at 11:00 a.m. at St. Sebastian Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church in Fonda. Burial will be in Mount Zion Cemetery in Fonda. Janice was born March 16, 1943, to Raymond and June (Roosa) Kendall in Clarion. At the age of 6, Janice moved to Fonda where she lived with her father and grandmother. She attended school at OLGCC, graduating in 1961. Janice attended cosmetology school in Fort Dodge, Iowa and worked as a stylist in Lytton and at the Fonda nursing home before beginning her 24-year tenure at the bank in Fonda.

she taught CCD, served on the church board and was a member of the Holy Family Society and Catholic Daughters of America.
