Joan C. Reed, age 86, of Lakeside, Iowa died Monday, May 11, 2020 at her home in Lakeside.

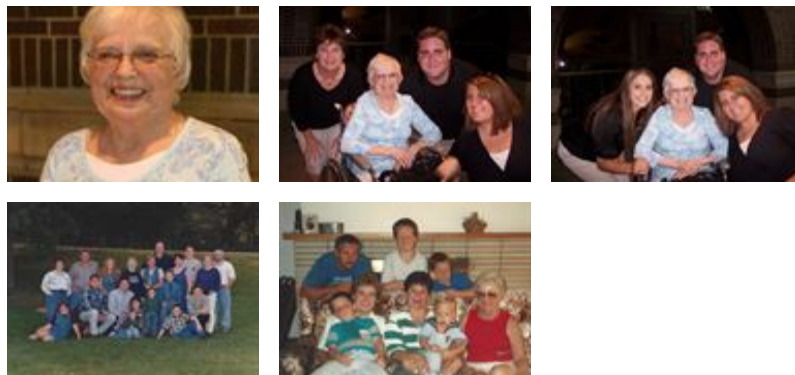
